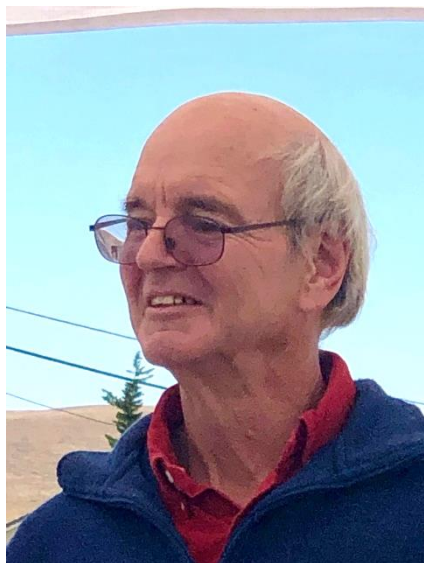

Don met with Jason Williams approximately 6-weeks ago to discuss the scheduling of a Rib Cook-Off. While the parklets are taking space on Third Street, Jason felt optimistic that the Cook-Off area could accommodate the parklets with booths being placed further down The Alameda. Due to the vendors being presently booked, Jason and Don agreed to schedule the Arts and Crafts Fair the weekend of Halloween. The Rib Cook-Off will hopefully be scheduled later in 2022.

The City Council is discussing other events, but at this point the City is limited to events of 100 people or less. The Council has extended the parklet ordinance through September, but Don believes the parklets will continue for some time after the extension.

Luis shared that he spoke with the president of the Rotary Club of Orizaba, our Club’s sister-club. They have both signed the certificate below and Luis and the Orizaba president are planning a ceremony to formalize the partnership. Details of a virtual ceremony will be communicated soon.



A global clean water project is in process for approval by the Area 6 World Service Committee. Next Rotary year, the Governor is slating a wheel chair donation campaign and therefore, wheel chairs may be included in the joint-projects with the Rotary Club of Orizaba.
