### **Orrin Mahoney, Rotary District Foundation Chairperson**

Mr. Mahoney is a member of the Rotary Club of Cupertino. He is a graduate of Carnegie Mellon University and earned his master's degree from Stanford University. He worked for Hewlett Packard for 35-years. Orrin served on the Cupertino City Council and was twice the major. He is a past president of his club and traveled throughout the world to assist with 11 Rotary International projects. In the 2017-2018 Rotary Year, Orrin was the District Governor and now the Foundation Chair.

Today, our members and guests were honored to listen to a presentation regarding the important work that the Rotary Foundation accomplishes.

Orrin stated, "In order to provide additional impact on the work the Foundation does around the world, they picked areas of focus, so that if you are doing a global grant in particular, it has to fit in these areas." They are Promoting Peace; Providing Clean Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene; Saving Mothers and Children; Fighting Disease; Supporting Education; and Growing Local Economies. Another area has been added this year: Environment.

Our District 5170 has been responsible for a great number of international projects. The following are just a few examples: Support during Hurricane María, Healthy Kidneys, China School of Vocational Teacher Training, Bus and Medical Team Transport, School for Special Needs Students, Women's Shelter, Faces of Hope (Cleft pallet reconstruction), Nigeria Water Wells, and a Model Village Water

Sanitation. The District over a two-year period has completed approximately a million dollars-worth of projects. We are one of the top contributors around the world.

The Annual Fund is the primary funding mechanism for local and international projects. One half of all the money donated comes back to the District and the Clubs in the form of District Designated Funds (DDF). The rest is used to match funding for Global Grant projects. The Annual Fund Campaign is completed in the Fall of each year. **The District's goal is to have Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) contribute to the Foundation. To qualify as a donor, a member should give at least \$25 with the hope that Rotarians will become Double Sustainers contributing \$200.** You may donate on *Rotary Direct* online. Your donation is automatically charged to your credit card. Once you have donated \$1,000 cumulatively, you become a Paul Harris Fellow. The Paul Harris Society status is earned when a \$1,000 is contributed all in one-year (either to the Annual Fund or Polio Plus).

The Polio Plus Drive is completed in the Spring. Just recently, the World Health Federation certified Nigeria and therefore Africa as Polio-Free. Pakistan and Afghanistan are the last two countries, that have Polio cases. It has been extremely difficult for Rotarians to administer vaccines in these countries due to the dangerous conditions. The Foundation is now matching donations for Polio Plus.

The Endowment exists mostly for those who have placed the Rotary Foundation in their wills/trusts. Last year, over \$5 million was donated from District 5170.

The Rotary Foundation spends our donations wisely as proven by receiving a four-star rating from Charity Navigation twelve-years in a row.
