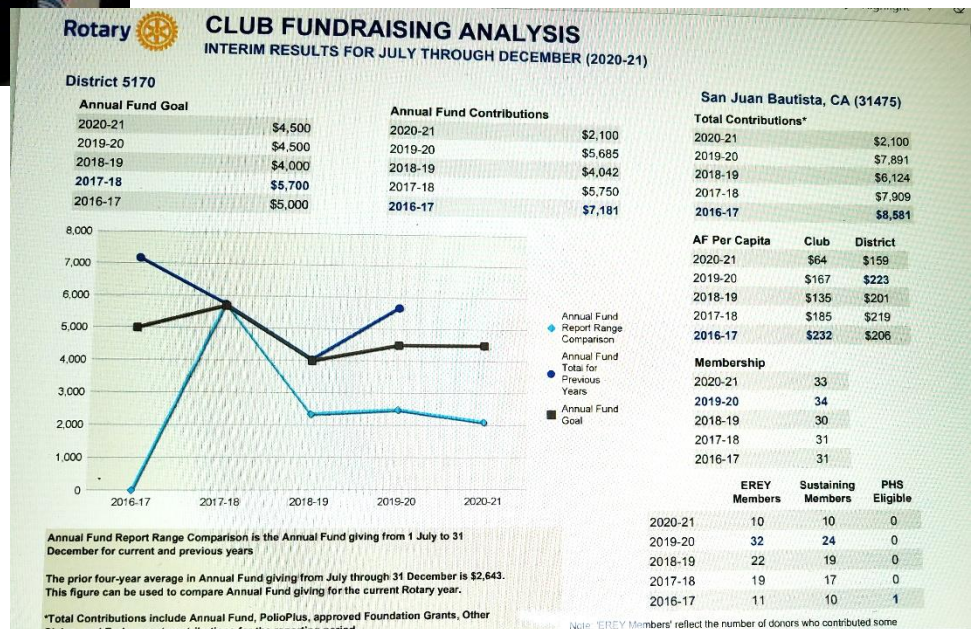


Club General Assembly Art Testani Jackie Muñoz

Art began this morning by showing an analysis of our members' Rotary Foundation contributions. The chart below compares our current mid-year performance and our annual goals. Thus far, our members have contributed \$2100. An additional \$450 has been collected by Bob, which will be forwarded in the near future.

Thirteen of our 30 members have contributed (\$2,550). The Club's expectation is that EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year) contributes to the Foundation.

Each year, our members review and revise the Club's Strategic Plan. Unfortunately, due to the Pandemic, the Club was unable to update the 2019-2020 Plan and therefore, we have utilized this Plan as our guide. The good news is that our membership has worked hard to continue implementing our written goals as well as numerous other projects not included in the 2019-20 Plan.

In preparation for a new Rotary Year, the Board of Directors asked Jackie to facilitate a planning session in order to update the Strategic Plan. Those in attendance this morning began by reviewing the 2019-20 Plan. They were asked to make suggestions for any goal to be deleted. No deletions were suggested though it was recommended that the Antique Fair be replaced by the Silent Auction and that the Ghost-Walk be both in-person and virtual.

The membership was then asked to make suggestions for new goals to be added to the 2021-2022 Plan. It should be noted that all of the discussion center around how best to help our community in recovering from the general order of shelter-in-place ensuring that we send a message of hope. The recommendations are as follows:

- Support and mobilize the Covid-19 Vaccine efforts: Create a committee
- Continue with food distribution
- Continue with family access to the internet (Broadband) in partnership with the School District, City and County
- Include support to local businesses; revitalization of downtown SJB & Aromas (auction local gift certificates, grants, etc.)
- Organize events inviting people to enjoy nature (The Pinnacles, Anza Trail, etc.): Create a committee (Note: Rotary is establishing a 6th Avenue of Service next year = Environmental Service)
- Create and activate an Arts Committee

The next step will be for the Board of Directors to discuss the above suggestions keeping in made what is doable by a club of 30 members. Goals will be created and the Plan will be distributed and discussed by the complete membership. Changes will be made to the draft Plan if needed and it will come back to the membership for approval.

The last item on today's agenda was the nomination of 2021-2022 Board of Directors. The election of Directors will take place at the end of January. The following members have been nominated thus far.
