General Assembly

Setting the tone for the year, Annette began by sharing her vision. *"We are such an awesome club. We are the little club that can and does. We have an amazing strategic plan that works for us every single year."*

In preparation to become the club president, Annette attended the President Elect Training Seminar. Past-Governor Richard King spoke about the eagle as a symbol of visionary leadership. Therefore, Annette has adopted the traits of great leadership for our club (i.e., being the change, being undeterred, and holding a high vision). Embracing these traits, her vision for the club is: *Lift the club, its members, and community to new heights, developing a deeper connection between our members and our community.*

Annette further stated, *"I wanted to invent our club with the acronym eagle.*

"So, my three goals are having impactful meetings, especially the General Assembly, expanding the program to global speakers. I also want to bring back that appreciation element to our expert speakers...The second is not only to follow the theme to change lives, but to also change our club image... I am going to put extra effort on making sure the community knows who we are. The third goal is fellowship...some form of fellowship that is beyond San Juan for this year.

I developed a little motivational tool for all of us this year and it's going to be called 'Six to Soar. There's going to be six things that I will be asking you to do that will earn you an Eagle badge."

Following Annette's opening statements, the 2021-2022 budget was discussed. The Club's beginning reserve is \$56,661.00. The Finance Committee developed the budget based on the Fundraising Committee's projections regarding revenue. The Board of Directors approved the budget at its July 15, 2021 meeting.

Standing committees have been existence for numerous years. The list of committees is always included in the newsletter listing chairpersons and members for each committee. Jackie commended the chairpersons for a job well done last year despite having to shelter-in-place. She then asked those attending to review the committee chart to ensure that the chairpersons and members will stay the same
