

Today we were honored to receive comments from our new Governor Gregg Giusiana as a long-standing Rotarian of the Gilroy Club.

Gregg has served as the Area 6 Assistant Governor twice as well as serving as the Lieutenant Governor. He has received the Richard D. King Award and Sydney R. Mitchell Rotarian of the Year Award.

*"A long time Gilroy resident, Giusiana has served as president of the Gilroy Garlic Festival, chair of the Gilroy Chamber of Commerce and was selected as Gilroy's Man of the Year in 2015. He worked for the Gilroy Police Department for 34 years, the last*

*10 as chief of police. He is currently is Vice President of Academy Services at South Bay Regional Public Safety Training in San Jose."* ([www.rotary5170.org](http://www.rotary5170.org))

Governor Giusiana will oversee Rotary District 5170, which consists of 61 clubs with 4,000 members. His message this morning was to emphasize the District's support of every club; members and presidents. As an example, there are chairpersons overseeing all the Avenues of Service. The charge of each chairperson is to give information and guidance to local club chairs. As well, Gregg highlighted two upcoming District events: Virtual Membership Seminar (Aug. 15<sup>th</sup>) and Where Do District Governors Come From (Sept. 26<sup>th</sup>).
