Congressman Jimmy Panetta

We had the honor of listening to Congressman Panetta speak via Zoom from Washington DC today. Jimmy was extremely informative regarding legislation completed in the recent past as well as issues coming to the Congress floor for discussion and approval.

Congressman Panetta stated, *"My job is to make the federal government work for you."* And certainly, he has by ensuring that the citizens of the United States had financial relief during the Covid 19 Pandemic. Five major relief bills have been passed with \$1.6 million distributed to San Benito

County effecting 7,520 jobs. Beyond this, the recent passing of the American Rescue Plan will allocate \$12 million to San Benito County with \$400,000 to San Juan Bautista. Furthermore, two tax credits have been passed: a Child Tax Credit and Earned Income Tax Credit. The Child Tax Credit will be completed automatically.

There has been a "war-time" deployment of vaccines throughout the nation. Partnership between health clinics and agriculture companies allowed the work force to be vaccinated in record time.

Congressman Panetta stated that he is cautiously optimistic about our nation's future. Yes, the vaccination deployment is showing success. The economy is thriving and many are able to travel again. That being said, the Delta variant is of great concern. While businesses are reopening, there is a shortage of workers. And the climate is once again causing droughts and therefore the chances of horrific fires are becoming a reality.

The Congressman spoke about so many other areas. As a synopsis, the following Bills have been approved by the House of Congress and have been sent to the Senate.

- Gun Safety Reforms: Background Checks
- Equality Act
- Paycheck Fairness Act
- Election Security Form
